An online data collection and storage system, for CSPs to manage information relating to people, clubs, activities and services offered within their locality.

What the solution offers

There are quite literally many thousands of sporting activities on offer at any one time. One role of a CSP is to be able to identify where and when these occur.

The other element is tracking the types of people who are getting involved with the activities.

The QES system sits at the heart of the organisation, collecting data from multiple sources and collating the results into manageable units.

Reporting of the collected data is key, whether that is for national KPI/NIs or for local management information purposes.

The QES solution

The QES MIS for County Sports Partnerships has been designed and built in conjunction with Kent County Council sports development unit and Wesport, based in Bristol.

The solution has three distinct sections:

- A back office area supporting the data collation and monitoring functions.
- An integrated reporting suite, for extracting the data.
- An optional public facing web front end allowing for public access to search for activities.

Automated data collection from other existing data sets is a common tool used by QES in solutions such as these.
